# Retaining remote workers

# How high-tech villages and home comforts are attracting and retaining employees

The oil and gas sector employs thousands of remote workers every year. Money used to be the main driver in attracting and retaining staff, however, other factors are now beginning to impact on a worker's decision to take or stay in a particular job. Accommodation, facilities, services, rosters, entertainment and communications are now major determinants in an employee's consideration process, and something smart employers are now looking to, to differentiate themselves.

Not long ago, remote sites were more like "camps" compared to today's "villages". They offered very basic accommodation and facilities consisting of shared living quarters, including beds, bathrooms, laundry facilities, a table tennis table, a pool table and free-to-air-TV. Since things have then. changed considerably. The booming Australian oil and gas market has



resulted in an influx of experienced and savvy resource workers. There is now fierce competition to keep the best staff, and companies are doing what they can to ensure employees don't leave.

#### Comforts of home

The greatest changes have occurred across entertainment, communications and financial services. Remote villages now provide family-focused rosters, better accommodation standards with ensuites and mini bars, and diverse facilities, from fully equipped gyms and sporting facilities to movie rooms and pubs for socialising. To help workers manage their finances while in remote locations, many oil and gas organisations are engaging the services of finance management experts for their staff.

### High-tech villages

Technology has driven major changes to village entertainment and communications to help bridge these gaps between workers and home. Whether texting or calling friends and family, Tweeting or catching up on Facebook, workers' desire for communications, service speed and technology has increased considerably. Employees on remote oil and gas

sites now expect nothing less. It is fair to say that communications technologies have drastically improved remote workers' standard of living by providing means of overcoming isolation

Adrian Ballintine, CEO of Australia's leading independent satellite communications company, NewSat Limited, believes, "We are seeing huge demand from oil and gas sites for digital entertainment platforms that provide 5-star hotel-grade in-room entertainment. It used to be just phone calls and Internet that remote workers wanted, but now we provide each worker with a secure entertainment platform, which gives them free-to-air TV, pay-per-view movies, Foxtel, radio, room-to-room communications, Internet and company specific announcements. And this is all enabled via satellite, rivalling many metropolitan solutions".

#### **Financial Services**

Having access to reliable financial services is becoming more and more important to remote workers. With many financial services being delivered via the Internet, having reliable access to communication technologies is vital to the every-day financial transactions made by remote workers. Often a personal approach is also required, something which banks and financial services providers are increasingly becoming aware of.

In commenting on the provision of financial services to remote workers, Ben Halliwell, Managing Director of Halliwell Morgan Pty Ltd said, "It is important to recognise that our role as advisers is foremost about providing accessible and prudent financial advice which caters to the specific needs of remote workers. Rather than offering them discrete individual products, we are interested in helping them make long-term investments and build a diversified portfolio. Technology has made a huge difference to the way we communicate and build relationships with our remote clients."

#### The future

It may be surprising that oil and gas companies are spending millions of dollars on modern comforts for employees, but it certainly makes a lot of sense. Not only does keeping employees connected and entertained via satellite ensure their general welfare, it also helps companies attract and retain the best workers in a highly competitive industry.


### Introduction to the ProjectConnect Dashboard

### **Activity Tabs**



There are a number of options in the Activity Tabs section:

- My Saved Search Activity: shows the number of results you will see if you were to run any of your saved searches, with a link to executing the searches (only available for subscribers to Business Search Package 1)
- Company Activity: shows all the opportunity registrations and edits that have been done by any user on your profile (only available to the Company Controller user)

- Latest News: show the latest newsletter summary and any other news items of interest (please note there may be multiple pages)




