





HOW TO REGISTER FOR OPPORTUNITIES ON THE FREE PUBLIC WEBSITE

Turn on your computer. To begin using the internet, click on either

- The Internet Explorer icon 
- Or the Mozilla Firefox icon 

To access the ProjectConnect website type www.projectconnect.com.au into the address bar at the top of the browser. The screen below will appear.

PROJECT STATUS UPDATE

On September 14, 2009, Chevron Australia and its Joint Venture Participants, ExxonMobil and Shell announced a final investment decision on the Gorgon Project.

Initial work began immediately on Barrow Island. First gas is planned for 2014.

The Final Investment Decision followed the grant of production licences and final State development approval, which was received at the official signing ceremony attended by Western Australian State Premier the Hon. Colin Barnett, M.L.A. and Australian Minister for Resources and Energy the Hon. Martin...

Once you decide on the project opportunity and choose whether to show interest in the “Full Package” or “Components of Package”, just tick its corresponding **green** check box. You will be taken to a page to see if you have a company profile stored on ProjectConnect.

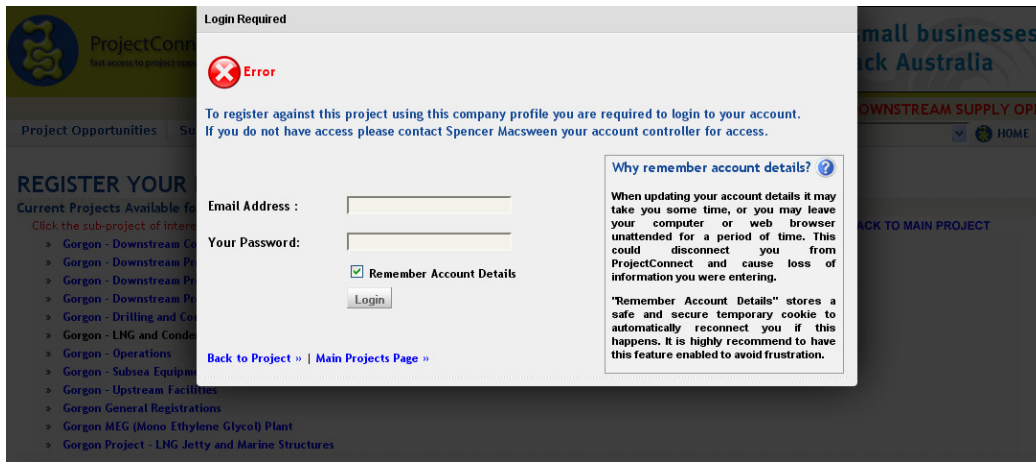
